



The Laboratoire Léon Brillouin is the French neutron scattering laboratory attached to the Orphée reactor. It is a member of the Paris Saclay University that gathered more than 10000 researchers. Each year it welcomes more than 300 scientists on its 22 neutron scattering instruments.

Conducting cutting edge research, it has been designated as the French hub to ESS with a participation in the construction of 5 of the first instruments of this new European infrastructure.
